- What events would lead to a lockdown?
- How will the lockdown be activated?
- What steps should staff take?
- How will staff communicate internally and externally?
- How will parents be informed?
- How often will drills be conducted?
- What training will staff receive?
- What support will be offered?
- How will the incident be reviewed?
- Which other policies does this link to?
- How often will the policy be reviewed?
