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


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
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Foreword!








Doncaster's Achievements So Far

We think Doncaster offers Children and Young People a great start in life and since our last Children & Young Peoples Plan in 2017 there have been lots of achievements:



In 2021, 97% of families received one of their top 3 preference schools, compared to 93% nationally



A new Mental Health Service 'With Me In Mind' has been rolled out in Schools across Doncaster



We have increased the voice and participation of primary aged Children by appointing a Junior Civic Mayor & Primary Ambassadors



We are the very first Local Authority in the Country to run a Junior Make
Your Mark Campaign



98% of our Early Years providers have been rated good or outstanding by OFSTED



2022 Make Your Mark results saw a total of 8,453 Young People taking part which is equivalent to 28.93% of the 11-18yrs population.



New Mental Health resources have been developed by Children & Young People and available in all schools and online.



71% of Doncaster Schools have been rated good or better by OFSTED



Permanent exclusions have reduced by 87% during 2020-2021




