



The Outcomes Rainbow

Outcomes in SEND Plans and EHCPs need to be positive and possible.

They must be Specific Measurable Acheivable Realistic and Time-bound (SMART) and aim to achieve something rather than refrain from something.

Though they need to be tailored to the child or young person, we recommend keeping a bank of outcomes for each area of need and amending these as needed.

Use the oucomes rainbow, to ensure that your outcomes are compliant with the SEND Code of Practice.

For example: By the end of Year 11, X will be able to run 5km, outside, independently, in 30 minutes, so that he can improve his fitness.
