Response

Notice under Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 - REFUSAL TO DISCLOSE INFORMATION

Decision:

After carefully considering your request for information the Council has decided that to respond to your request would exceed the appropriate limit as defined in the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Basis for decision:

Section 12(1) of the Freedom of Information Act allows for a request for information to be refused where the cost of supplying this information exceeds the appropriate limit. After carefully considering your request for information the Council has decided that to respond to your request would exceed the appropriate limit as defined in the <u>Freedom of Information</u> (<u>Appropriate Limit and Fees</u>) <u>Regulations 2004</u>. The regulations allow a request for information to be refused where the cost of supplying this information exceeds £450 (or 18 hours of officer time).

Why does the exemption apply in this case?

The cost limit applies in this case because City of Doncaster Council would need to extract sole trader or partnership information, which is personal data and would therefore be refused, from the business information you require. In order to do this, a total of 9824 records will need to be reviewed. It is estimated that each record will require a 15 second investigation resulting in a total time of approximately 40 hours, which would exceed the time limit.

We are unable to advise how you can make your request more specific however you might find it helpful to consult the Valuation Office website at: https://www.gov.uk/find-business-rates where you can search by authority to obtain a list of all the properties that are rated in Doncaster.
