

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 1 August 2023 for information about Attacks on Civil Enforcement Officers. Please find below City of Doncaster Council's responses to the questions you have raised.

Request

In the last financial year (2022/23), how many incidents did your authority record where traffic wardens - otherwise known as Civil Enforcement Officers - were assaulted by members of the public while carrying out council duties?

Please give a brief description of the circumstances of each recorded incident.

Response

Four incidents were recorded in the financial year (2022/23), all the incidents resulted in minor assaults with pushing/shoving and in one case spitting at a CEO. Each case involved threats of physical assaults, in one case a threat to kill the CEO.

I hope that this information is useful to you.
