Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 16 April 2024 for information about dog waste bins. Please find below City of Doncaster Council's responses to the questions you have raised.

- 1. Please state the number of dog poo bins that were in place in your area in:
- a) 2024 = 2599
- b) 2023 = 2553
- c) 2022 = 2623

Please note that these numbers are for all street litter bins within the borough. We do not hold the information specifically for dog bins as all our bins are dual purpose for both litter and dog waste.

2. If the number has declined, what was the reason for this?

The number has declined due to us rationalising litter bin provision and providing larger capacity bins where appropriate, thus reducing the number of individual bins provided but increasing the overall capacity for bin waste.
