Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 14 August 2023 for information about Private Rented Sector Enforcement. Please find attached the City of Doncaster Council's responses to the questions you have raised.

Please note, some figures are shown as <5 as it has been decided this information is exempt from disclosure under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The information requested is third party personal data (i.e. personal data about someone other than you). Section 40(2) provides that information which is third party personal data is exempt from disclosure if one of three conditions is satisfied. In this case, disclosure would contravene one of the data protection principles as the Council believes that the release of any such information and low figures in this regard could lead to the identification of an individual who otherwise would not expect their personal information to be released into the public domain.
