City of Doncaster Council is a local authority led by an elected Mayor

Mayor Jones has a cabinet of 4 members, chosen from the Elected Members of the Council, to support her. The Mayor can appoint up to 9 elected members to be part of her Cabinet.

Working within the policy and budget framework approved by Council, the Mayor and Cabinet make executive decisions to improve the city.

The Mayoral model incorporates an Overview and Scrutiny function made up from the remaining councillors. This function assists the Executive in policy formulation and review and also holds the Executive to account for decisions taken.

As Doncaster's leading ambassador outside the city, the Mayor represents the views of Doncaster to a wider audience to influence regional and national policy in favour of the city.

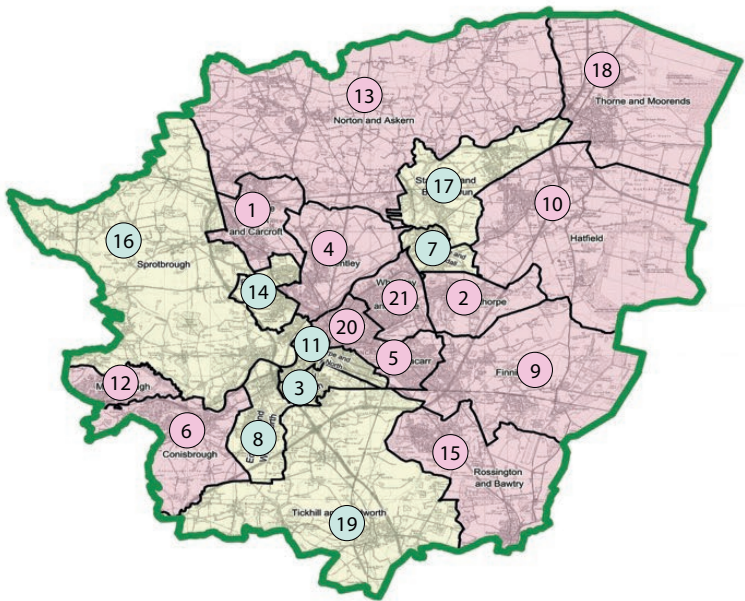
