The full width of a section of Barnburgh footpath no. 3 commencing from the existing footpath at grid reference SE 4908 0356 (point A on the order map) and proceeding north-north-westerly along the field boundary for some 24 metres before heading generally easterly through the wood for some 115 metres to the existing footpath at grid reference SE 4918 0359 (point B on the order map).

The full width of a section of Barnburgh footpath no. 3 commencing from the existing footpath at grid reference SE 4921 0359 (point C on the order map) and proceeding generally north-easterly along the watercourse for some 138 metres to the existing footpath at grid reference SE 4932 0367 (point D on the order map).

The full width of Barnburgh footpath no. 7 commencing from grid reference SE 4932 0360 (point E on the order map) and proceeding east-south-easterly along the field boundary for some 308 metres to Barnburgh bridleway no. 4 at grid reference SE 4959 0347 (point F on the order map).
