



To ensure the segregated cycle lane/footway are clear the cycleway will be surfaced in red tarmac with a 150mm white line to segregate pedestrians and cycles. The footway on the scheme will be kept to the maximum width possible to ensure pedestrians have sufficient space.

The South Parade scheme will connect active travel users to facilities on Bennetthorpe, Hall Gate and Thorne Road as well as connecting people to green space at Town Field Park

All the existing carriageway will be resurfaced from Regent hotel to Cenotaph as we are moving the kerb lines and removing the central islands

Upgrades made to the access so residents can access garages

- Footway -Excavate 20mm and lay 20mm thickness of AC6 dense surface or overlay 20mm where suitable
  - After excavation and preparation. Lay Moorcroft stone paving, wire cut (supplied by client) 600mm x RLx 63mm laid on 40mm bed of 3:1 sand cement screed on Polypropylene geogrid Strac: G20PP (or similar approved) on 60mm thick AC20BIN on existing compacted sub base. 10mm joints filled with Instarmac Ultrascapc Flowpoint grout BS7533 compliant mortar. Expansion joints every 10m row and next to buildings. NB: Due to the nature of natural stone and to ensure random colour mix, 4 crates of flags should be opened on site at all times and flags should be randomly selected from 4 crates.
  - Pave existing footpath material to a depth of 60mm. Mechanically clean surface, apply K170 bond coat and resurface with: Slesbath Colourfast V (RED PIGMENTED) 6mm Surface Course, laid 20mm thick AC 20 Dense Bin 100/150 laid 45mm thick
  - Carriageway resurfacing
  - Bus lane - green tarmac
  - Buff resin
  - Rain Garden
  - Collect and lay Conservation X kerb 145 x 255 in charcoal on a concrete bed. (radius and drop kerbs included)
  - Collect from DMBC and lay Conservation X Edging 63x150x915 Charcoal
  - Supply and lay pre-cast concrete channeling group C3 / 100 (150 x 230)
  - Knee guard rail
  - Install new Manchester removable bollards
  - Remove and dispose existing bollards
