CREATION AND DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2025

This Order is made by City of Doncaster Council ("the authority") under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that, having regard to the matters set out in section 26(1), there is a need for public bridleways over the land to which this order relates, and that it is expedient that the ways should be created.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Area 3) definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(iii) of the 1981 Act, namely, the creation (as authorised by this order) of a new right of way over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. There shall be from the date of confirmation of this order public bridleways over the land at Barnburgh and High Melton described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this order, and thereupon The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Area 3) definitive map shall be modified by adding those paths to it, and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this order.
2. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is the date upon which the order comes into effect.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

A bridleway with a width of 3.5 metres commencing from Harlington Road at grid reference SE 4891 0263 (point A on the order map) and proceeding south for 530 metres to grid reference SE 4896 0210 (point B on the order plan) where there is a reduction in width to 1.5 metres for a distance of 10 metres, then continuing south east for 515 metres to the parish boundary at grid reference SE 4934 0182 (point C on the order plan).

A bridleway with a width of 3.5 metres commencing at the parish boundary at grid reference SE 4934 0182 (point C on the order plan) and proceeding east for 25 metres to grid reference SE 4937 0183 (point D on the order plan) where there is a reduction in width to 1.3 metres for a distance of 10 metres. Continuing east through Barnburgh Grange for a distance of 510 metres to grid reference SE 4984 0176 (point E on the order plan) where there is a reduction in width to 1.4 metres for a distance of 20 metres, then continuing east for a distance of 50 metres to Melton Mill Lane at grid reference SE4990 0177 (point F on the order plan).

Modification of Definitive Statement

Variation of Particulars of Path or Way

The following shall be added for the parish of Barnburgh:

Width	3.5 metres & 1.5 metres

The following shall be added for the parish of High Melton:

Description of Route	Bridleway commencing at its junction with Barnburgh No.5 proceeding in an easterly direction through Barnburgh Grange to Melton Mill Lane, with a reduction in width to 1.3 metres for a distance of 10 metres at grid reference SE 4937 0183 and 1.4 metres for a distance of 20 metres at grid reference SE 4984 0176.
Nature of Surface	Stone
Approximate Length	615 metres
Width	3.5 metres, 1.3 metres & 1.4 metres
