This Order is made by Doncaster Borough Council ("the authority") under section 118A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act").

The footpath in the authority's area described below crosses a railway otherwise than by a tunnel or bridge.

It appears to the authority that it is expedient in the interests of the safety of members of the public using, or likely to use, the said footpath that it should be stopped up.

The authority has required the operator of the railway to enter into an agreement with it to defray any expenses which the authority may incur in connection with the erection or maintenance of barriers and signs.

THIS ORDER EXTINGUISHES the public right of way over the land situate at Rossington shown by a continuous bold line on the map attached to this order and described in the schedule after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

Public footpath Rossington Number 10 (Part) – section A – B.

Public footpath commencing at Grid Reference SK 6296 9702 (Point A) on the west side of the fence alongside the East Coast Main Line, proceeding in an east direction for 56 metres to Grid Reference SK 6302 9703 (Point B) on the east side of the line, as shown on the order map by a continuous bold black line.
