Climate Doncaster is pleased to invite you to take part in a new course on **24 April 2025**, which is specifically aimed at school leaders, bringing climate understanding and action into your educational setting.

Through collaboration with the Carbon Literacy Project, Climate Doncaster is able to extend this offer to your setting free of charge.

The course is available to teaching staff, finance and business leads, facilities management, school governors, and leadership. It will include **7 hours** of interactive learning taking place at **Danum Gallery, Library, and Museum (Waterdale, Doncaster, DN1 3BZ) on 24 April 2025, from 10:00 – 17:00.**

We are fortunate to be able to offer this course free of charge to educational staff, supporting the DfE Sustainability & Climate Change strategy, which requires all schools to complete a climate action plan by the end of 2025. Throughout the one-day session, participants will explore:

- Climate equity & vulnerability
