Stockbridge Lane from a point 490 metres south west of its junction with A19 Doncaster Road and Sutton Road to where the road terminates at the arches next to 1 Stable Yard Cottages.

North Park Lane from its junction with Stockbridge Lane for a distance of 94 metres in a generally northerly direction.

(ii) Introduce the following item in Schedule 2.01 of the Order 30mph Speed Limit:-

That length of Stockbridge Lane Owston which extends from its junction with A19 Doncaster Road and Sutton Road for a distance of 490 metres in a generally south westerly direction.

(ii) The following item was included in Schedule 2.01 of the Order 30mph Speed Limit:-


