The effect of the Order will be to introduce a No waiting at any time restriction on the following length of road:-

## Weston Road, Balby

South side

From a point 12 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of Goldsmith Road for a distance of 55 metres in an easterly direction.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods and in connection with building industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for the collection and delivery of postal packets or if it is a vehicle being operated by or on behalf of the South Yorkshire Safety Camera Partnerships while carrying out roadside monitoring or enforcement operations. The usual exceptions for disabled persons vehicles will also apply.




