Notice is hereby given that the City of Doncaster Council proposes to make an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a No waiting at any time restriction on the following lengths of road:-

i) Valley Drive, Branton

South-east side

from a point 10 metres north-east of its intersection with the extended north-eastern kerb-line of Rural Crescent, for a distance of 25 metres in a south-westerly direction

ii) Rural Crescent, Branton

Both sides

From its junction with Valley Drive, for a distance of 10 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods and in connection with building industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for the collection and delivery of postal packets or if it is a vehicle being operated by or on behalf of the South Yorkshire Safety Camera Partnerships while carrying out roadside monitoring or enforcement operations. The usual exceptions for disabled persons vehicles will also apply.

The proposed traffic regulation order is necessary to prohibit vehicle parking at the location in question which may impede the free flow of traffic and obstruct access for vehicles and pedestrians. - 1 The City of Doncaster Council (Various Roads, Doncaster) (Parking, Stopping, Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2018 shall have the effect as though the following items were included in Schedule 1.03 No waiting at any time:
 - i) Valley Drive, Branton

South-east side

from a point 10 metres north-east of its intersection with the extended north-eastern kerbline of Rural Crescent, for a distance of 25 metres in a south-westerly direction

ii) Rural Crescent, Branton

Both sides

From its junction with Valley Drive, for a distance of 10 metres in a south-easterly direction.

This Order shall come into operation on the day of 2025 and may be cited as the "City of Doncaster Council (Various Roads, Doncaster) (Parking, Stopping, Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2018 (Amendment No.) Order 2025".
