



DUTY TO CONSULT ON FELLING STREET TREES

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be felled. From the date of this notice there is a period of at least 28 days in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021 and section 96A of the Highways Act 1980 on the duty to consult.

Notice date: Tuesday 30th September 2025

Reference: A6023 Greens Way / West Street junction and Car Park improvements T3

Location: Latitude 53.493171 / Longitude -1.2923047 Car Park, John Street, Mexborough, Doncaster, S64 9HS

Species: Tilia x europaea / Lime

Reason for removal: To provide space to accommodate alterations to the road and car park layout including additional parking spaces, and improved pedestrian and cycling facilities.

Solutions considered: It is not possible to deliver the alterations to the road and car park layout to achieve additional parking spaces and improved pedestrian and cycling facilities without removing the trees due to the position of surrounding properties and the available space.

Replacement: There are three trees in this area that are proposed to be felled. The felled trees will be replaced with nine trees with additional trees to be planted elsewhere in Mexborough as part of a wider highway scheme.
