



DUTY TO CONSULT ON FELLING STREET TREES

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be felled. From the date of this notice there is a period of at least 28 days in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021 and section 96A of the Highways Act 1980 on the duty to consult.

Species: Prunus Kanzan / Ornamental Cherry

Reason for removal: To provide the space needed to alter the layout of the Market Street and Greens Way junction. The changed junction layout will enable vehicles to enter and exit Greens Way at this junction and replaces the current layout where access is currently restricted to exit from Greens Way only.

Solutions considered: It is not possible to construct the new access without removing the trees due to the available space and road layout.

Replacement: There are two trees in this area that are proposed to be felled. The felled trees will be replaced with three trees with additional trees to be planted elsewhere in Mexborough as part of a wider highway scheme.
