



## DUTY TO CONSULT ON FELLING STREET TREES

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be felled. From the date of this notice there is a period of at least 28 days in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021 and section 96A of the Highways Act 1980 on the duty to consult.

**Species:** Malus tschonoskii / Crab Apple

**Reason for removal:** To allow space from the central reserve to be used to make alterations to the junction between Greens Way and Bank Street. These include providing access from the westbound carriageway and improved pedestrian and cycling facilities whilst retaining appropriate safety buffers and dual lanes on the approach to Adwick Road roundabout.

**Solutions considered:** It is not possible to make the alterations to the junction without removing the trees due to other constraints in this location including surrounding businesses and residential properties and utilities infrastructure below ground.

**Replacement:** There are five trees in this area that are proposed to be felled. The felled trees will be replaced with eight trees with additional trees to be planted elsewhere in Mexborough as part of a wider highway scheme.
